Class Descriptions:

RPT (Retrieval Proficiency Test):

The RPT is the first stepping stone. Your dogs must pass an RPT to go on to the other events and collect points. An RPT is a simple retrieving test. You dog may retrieve any object (your choice). You stand in a square that is 6 feet by 6 feet. You may not leave this “handler’s box”. You throw your object 10 yards or more and send your dog to retrieve it. Your dog must retrieve the object and return it to you or drop it within the handler’s box. Your dog only has to do this successfully

once and he will have passed his RPT and will earn a certificate and be able to go on to compete for points and titles in all of the other events.

Single Disc:

Single Disc is the most popular event. In this event you have one official Fastback Frisbee (supplied by the host club) and two one minute rounds to get as many catches as you can. For each catch your dog makes you earn points: 1 point for over 10 yards; 3 points for over 15 yards; 5 points for over 20 yards. If your dog has all four feet off the ground at the time of the catch (getting air) you earn an extra bonus point for that catch. All your points are added up for the two rounds for your overall score. Points are tracked and titles are awarded when certain numbers of points are earned. You also can earn proficiency titles in Single disc. You will earn a qualifying leg if your dog catches the disc over the 20 yard line four times within the first seven throws. Once you earn 4 legs your dog is awarded the Basic Disc Dog (BDD) title and moves up to Advanced.

Freestyle Disc:

In a nut shell it is a 90 second routine of tricks and catches to music.

Disc Off:

This is an **unofficial class. This class is just for fun but you can still receive prizes and ribbons. The rules of Disc Off are simple, you have two minutes for your dog to catch as many discs as possible. Discs caught over the first yard line earn 10 points, the second yard line 15 points, the third yard line 20 points. You can use as many discs as you like but the dog must be behind the throw line for each throw.**

Other basic rules:

Only Official Fastback Frisbees can be used in the regular division. Only Official K10 Pup discs can be used in the mini division (for dogs less than 15 inches tall).

No food or other toys are permitted on the green. Fouling the green will mean elimination for that round specific round.

All dogs must be on leash or crated when not competing. Respect other dogs` personal space.

Registration Agreement

This agreement must be signed before your dog can participate in the above events.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, the holding of this event and the opportunity to have the dog participate or be judged, I (we) agree to hold the organizing committee, the organization which it represents, including its members, officers and directors, owners of premises upon which the event is held and their employees, harmless from any claim for loss of injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person of thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence or any other person, or any other cause or causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and same the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposes by the law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
